### Call to Order:

- Chairman Law called the meeting to order at 7:00 pm.

### Declaration of Quorum:

- There are currently 365 voting members of the Clark County Republican Committee (CCRC).

      - 17 ayes for accepting one nomination, 9 ayes for opening the floor.
